The Defendant has been guilty of extreme and repeated acts of mental cruelty, without cause or provocation on the part of the Plaintiff.

The court therefore ORDERS as follows:

A. The marriage of the Plaintiff and Defendant is dissolved.

**B. Child Custody**

1. \_\_\_\_\_ is awarded the exclusive custody of the minor child/children, subject to the non-custodial parent's right to reasonable visitation.

The parties are awarded the joint custody of the minor child/children, with \_\_\_\_\_ the primary residential parent.

**C. Child Support**

  - a. the child finishing high school coupled with the child's 18th birthday;
  - b. the child establishing an independent residence;

**D. Medical Insurance and Expenses**

- 1. Unless the parties otherwise agree in writing, the non-custodial parent shall provide the minor children with medical insurance, including major medical coverage if available through employment.
- 2. Each party shall be responsible for the payment of one half of any deductible and one half of any medical (including prescription drugs), dental, orthodontia, ophthalmological, psychiatric or psychological expenses for the minor children not covered by insurance.
- 3. All reimbursements, one party to the other for medical expenses for the minor children, shall be paid within thirty days of the date the party paying the expense tenders to the other party proof of payment.

**E. College Education**

The question of the payment of college educational expenses for the minor children is hereby expressly reserved.

**F. Distribution of Property**

- 1. The Plaintiff is awarded the following marital property:
  - a. Any personal property in the Plaintiff's possession and control.

- b. Any bank accounts, checking accounts, savings accounts, currently exclusively in the Plaintiff's name.

**G.** Each party is denied maintenance.
