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This report lists all transportation projects receiving Federal funds during the 2010 fiscal year. All projects located within the Springfield Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) are listed by their Transportation Improvement Program project number (TIP Project #). Projects located outside of the MPA are not assigned TIP numbers.

Data pertaining to the 2010-2013 TIP, Project Descriptions, Bike and/or Pedestrian Components, and Phase of Work were obtained from Springfield Area Transportation Study TIP documents and the 2035 Long-Range Transportation Plan.

Data pertaining to the Federal Funding Obligated in FY 2010 and the Federal Funding Source Obligated were obtained from the Federal Highway Administration FMIS report for Sangamon County.

Federal Funds Remaining Available for Obligation reflects any remaining balance between the Federal Funds indicated in the TIP and the Federal Funds Obligated amount listed in the FMIS report.



