

WORKPLACE SAFETY BOARD MINUTES
March 28, 2017

Chair Bunch called the meeting to order.

Bunch requested a motion to approve the minutes from the January 31, 2017 meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Krell and seconded by Ritzer. Motion carried.

The Committee reviewed new cases 17-06 – 17-11. Discussion/recommendations made were: Case 17-07 - purchase smaller bags of dog food (25 lbs) or to request help in loading/unloading; Case 17-08 - McCrady will check on what gloves were purchased with the IPRF Safety Grant approximately 2 years ago; and, 17-09 and 1710 – check with Sheriff's Office, and possibly Court Services and Public Health, on Hepatitis C immunizations and whether training is offered.

Stratton reported to the committee that the glass chair mats purchased in the Circuit Clerks office have been removed, except for those where the employee requested to keep theirs.

Bloch informed the committee on various safety trainings that he can provided to the County. Topics include Blood Borne Pathogens, confined space, personal protections equipment, hazard communication, lockout/tagout, trenching and shoring, fire extinguisher, hearing conservation, safe lifting, flagger, defensive driving, forklift, slip/trip/fall, and various simulator training.

There was no old business or public comment.

A motion to adjourn was made by Krell and seconded by Goleman. Meeting adjourned.
