

ELECTION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE  
APRIL 10, 2017

Chairman Snell called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. Bunch made the motion to approve the meeting minutes from the March 14, 2017 meeting and Madonia seconded the motion. Motion carried (6-0).

County Clerk Gray reported that the election was successful but the turnout was only 13.79%. It was the least in Sangamon County history. We had 799 early voters, 171 same day registration voters and 713 absentee voters. All votes that have not been counted already, will be counted on the 18<sup>th</sup>. The election should be certified by April 21<sup>st</sup>. The vital records mobile unit will launch this weekend in Chatham. It will be at the Chatham Village Hall. Gray says they will be doing one event a week through mid-July. Places and dates are on the County Clerk’s website. Stacey will be getting the election judge & registrar’s pay ready in the next couple of days for signatures from the committee. The committee discussed how to save money for the next election but it’s hard to predict voter turnout.

The requisitions were reviewed and signed. Bunch motioned to approve the requisitions and Scaife seconded. Motion carried (8-0).

There was no other old business or public comment. Bunch motioned to adjourn and Madonia seconded. Motion carried (8-0) and the meeting adjourned at 4:41 pm.
