Chairman Snell called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. ***Bunch made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the August 8th meeting and Tjelmeland seconded the motion. Motion carried (7-0).***

Don reported on the vital records & voting registration mobile unit. His office has ten upcoming events with the Senior Living facilities beginning the first week of October until the third week of December. We are still in discussion with Organized Labor, Farm Bureau & District 186 to provide for registrations.

September 26<sup>th</sup> is National Voter Registration Day. There will be 4 events with local libraries (Chatham, Sherman, Rochester and West Sangamon in New Berlin). We will have after hours at those libraries to register voters, as well as extending the County Elections office too. The committee discussed motor voter registration and the different IDs that the Secretary of State's office has now.

Gray says he has submitted his budget back to the auditor's office with a 31,000 change in budget due to the increase in election judge pay.

Gray attended a Cyber Security Fall Conference here in Springfield.
