

ELECTION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
JULY 10, 2018

Chairman Snell called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. ***Bunch made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the June 12th meeting and Madonia seconded. Motion carried (9-0).***

Stacey reported that we had an objection hearing last week. There was an objection filed for District 3, stating that the opponent didn’t have enough valid signatures. The electoral board heard the case and it was ruled that the opponent didn’t have enough signatures and won’t be on the ballot. Write in candidates have until 9/6 to file. The State Board of Elections has three objections pending and they will be having their own hearings. August 24th is the last day for the State Board of Elections to certify the names of candidates, questions to amend the Constitution and any statewide questions of public policy. August 20th is the last day for local governing boards to adopt a resolution or ordinance to allow binding public questions to appear on the ballot. August 30th is when it will be certified to the elections office. After September 6th, the Gray’s office can get the ballot ready. For the 2019 election, the Board of Elections will issue their official calendar and once they issue it, we will put our packets together. August 28th is when candidates can start circulating nomination papers. Stacey said that they are still working out the details for the election night reporting package contract. Signature pads will be coming next week and they will be testing them. Today was the first day that our elections office got the electronic registrations from the Secretary of State’s office.

Tonight at the County Board Meeting, we are presenting the appointment of Election Judges for the 2018-2020 term.

The requisitions were reviewed and signed. ***Bunch motioned to approve the requisitions and Sheehan seconded. Motion carried (10-0).***

There was no old business or public comment.

Tjelmeland motioned to adjourn and Scaife seconded. Motion carried (10-0) and the meeting adjourned at 4:36 pm.
