Vice Chairman Madonia called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. **Bunch made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the July 10th meeting and Tjelmeland seconded. Motion carried (8-0).**

Don reported that election judge assignments have been sent to precinct committeemen for review and feedback. We are in the process of finalizing our election judges & registrars for November. We are actively recruiting for poll workers. We need more workers this year because it's an even year. As of today, we have 900 assigned election judges & 160 registrars. We are recruiting on social media & the County Clerk's office is working with Jeff Vose at the Regional Office of Education for students and each school's administrator. A student worker must be a junior or senior with a qualifying GPA. We are also looking at county employees as a backup if needed. Gray's office is working with the Supervisor of Assessments office & the Recorder's office. Selfies are illegal in Illinois so the County Clerk's office is constructing a selfie booth for voters if they want to take one AFTER they vote.

The period to receive vote-by-mail applications is open. (in person or on paper) County Clerk's office is also designing window clings for their windows on 9<sup>th</sup> street as a marketing tool. If you request a ballot by mail, we will include an "I voted by mail" sticker in the packet. 2019 Consolidated election info is on our website. August 28<sup>th</sup> is the first date to circulate petitions.

- Approval to enter into a contract for Election Night Reporting with ScytI **Bunch made a motion to approve and O'Neill seconded. Motion carried (8-0)**
- Approval to hire two (2) temp/seasonal positions to assist with early voting & grace period registration for the General Election at an hourly rate of \$12.00/hr effective 9/10/18. **O'Neill made a motion to approve and Scaife seconded. Motion carried (8-0)**

The requisitions were reviewed and signed. **Bunch motioned to approve the requisitions and Sheehan seconded. Motion carried (8-0).**

There was no old business or public comment.

**Bunch motioned to adjourn and Tjelmeland seconded. Motion carried (8-0) and the meeting adjourned at 4:44 pm.**
