Chairman Snell called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. ***Bunch made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the October 9th meeting and Sheehan seconded. Motion carried (8-0).***

Don reported that the November 6<sup>th</sup> election was very successful. We had a 63.92% voter turnout. That is the highest since 2002. We had a very successful early vote totaling 19,408. We still have 83 provisional ballots outstanding. We are waiting on over 1000 ballots to be returned & as long as they are postmarked on 11/6, they will be counted. Election Day was smooth. Gray says that their voting machines are aging and his department is going to take a look at them & plan for the future. Same day registration system worked very well. We had 900 election workers & 160 registrars. Stacey is working on getting the paperwork done so all the workers can be paid. The selfie station was very popular.

The requisitions were reviewed and signed. ***Bunch motioned to approve the requisitions and Tjelmeland seconded. Motion carried (8-0).***

There was no old business or public comment.

***Sheehan motioned to adjourn and Miller seconded. Motion carried (8-0) and the meeting adjourned at 4:44 pm.***
