

JAIL COMMITTEE MEETING
MINUTES
APRIL 3, 2018

Chairman Tjelmeland called the meeting to order at 1202p.

REPORTS:

Sheriff Barr –reported that August 1-5th, the 41st Annual National Bikers Roundup will be at the Illinois State Fairgrounds. There could be between 25,000-35,000 bikers in town.

Chief Roesch –no report given

Superintendent Beck reported the jail count was 283. The average daily population is 294. Overtime is below average this week. We have 29 applicants that are eligible for our Correctional Officer testing. April 14th is the physical test & April 28th is the written test. We will have PTI training next week. Sheriff Barr says the jail count may be lower due to the bond reduction law and also because judges have been coming in on Sundays.

Deputy Coroner Jim Allmon reported that in their office it is business as usual. March was very busy.
