

JAIL COMMITTEE MEETING  
MINUTES  
JUNE 19, 2018

Chairman Tjelmeland called the meeting to order at 1200p.

Tjelmeland requested a motion to approve the minutes of the June 5, 2018 Jail Committee meeting. **Motion was made by Sheehan & seconded by Krell. Motion carried (6-0).**

**REPORTS:**

Sheriff Barr –his office has been extremely busy in the last week & a half looking for a missing man on Vignal Road. He still has not been found. We had a double homicide this past weekend. (1 in the city, 1 in the county) We have a suspect in custody. All 3 involved knew each other. Within about 24 hours, they had the suspect in custody.

Chief Roesch – The detective bureau did a great job finding him. They worked 24 hours to get him. Chief also reported that they are having problems with speeders on Woodside Road in the construction zone. So, the Sheriff's Office ended up having 25 traffic stops in 2 days. The traffic seems to be slowing down now.

Superintendent Beck reported the jail count at 359. They are still in the process of getting correction officers. There are 20 on the list and we need to hire 6. It's hard to get people to test. Beck says you have to be 21 to be hired.

Coroner Report-Edwards reported that her office has been busy. One of the victims of the double homicide was a former County Board Member's son. She had to deliver the news & that was very hard.

Douglas-Williams asked the Sheriff if the city & the county are working closely together this summer. She said the reason she's asking is because she's seen a lot of sheriff's vehicles in the city area. Sheriff says we've always worked closely together but the busier we are, the more you will see our vehicles around.

**New Business:**

Tim Eggleston:

- MJ Kellner approval \$9,457.37 Chairman Tjelmeland asked for a motion to approve MJ Kellner. **Sheehan made a motion to approve & Preckwinkle seconded. Motion carried (8-0) Preckwinkle said that if MJ Kellner gives us a discount because we pay quicker, maybe they can look into other vendors doing that as well.**

**Old Business:** none.

Chairman Tjelmeland requested a motion to approve the requisitions for the Sheriff & Coroner. **Ruzic made a motion to approve and Douglas-Williams seconded. Motion carried (8-0).**

*Douglas- Williams made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Fulgenzi. Motion carried (8-0) and the meeting adjourned at 12:11pm.*
