

JAIL COMMITTEE MEETING
MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 4, 2018

Chairman Tjelmeland called the meeting to order at 1200p.

REPORTS:

Sheriff & Chief-no report

Superintendent Beck reported that the jail count is 349. Overtime wasn't too bad this week. They will have a new Correction Officer start on 9/6. There are 5 new hires that will start PTI training on the 10th.

Coroner Edwards reported that there were 2 drowning deaths over the weekend. The recovery process included the Fire Department, County Rescue Squad & the Mennonite Search & Rescue. All worked well together to recover the remains. Two people in the boat witnessed the drownings. One of the men jumped in to save the other & they both drowned.

New Business:

Tim Eggleston:

- MJ Kellner approval \$9,820.34 ***DelGiorno made a motion to approve & Sheehan seconded. Motion carried (6-0)***
- Approve to hire a replacement Court Security Officer at an annual salary of \$35,760 effective September 5, 2018. Sheriff said they want to hire without the 30 day lag because this person was scheduled already to go to PTI on 9/10 and they already had the spot, so they want the committee's permission to waive the 30 days. It went through Finance already, they spoke with Joel about it and Brian. Eggleston said if they don't get approval to hire now, it will probably be the 1st of the year before they could get someone in to PTI. ***Ruzic made a motion to approve & Douglas-Williams seconded. Motion carried (6-0)***
- Pre-Travel request for Sheriff Wes Barr to attend the White House Conference with Illinois State and Local Leaders in Washington, DC on September 13th at a cost of \$829.04. ***Ruzic made a motion to approve & Krell seconded. Motion carried (6-0)***
- Request for John Osmer to attend Search Warrant Major Case Investigation Training on Sept. 10th and 11th in Bloomington, IL at a cost of \$295.00
- Request for John Hayes and Audie Prange to attend Solo Officer Rapid Deployment Alert Training on Sept. 11th and 12th in Jonesboro, AK at a cost of \$175.00 ***DelGiorno made a motion to approve both travels (Bloomington & AR) & Sheehan seconded. Motion carried (6-0)***

Old Business: none.

Chairman Tjelmeland requested a motion to approve the requisitions for the Sheriff & Coroner. ***DelGiorno made a motion to approve and Douglas-Williams seconded. Motion carried (6-0).***
