**REPORTS:**

Sheriff Campbell reported that they have released to the media that we are going to be hiring Correction Officers. The physical agility test will be June 1<sup>st</sup>. followed shortly by the written test. Starting salary is \$35,000. Sheriff wanted to explain to those that are also on the Finance committee because there was a vehicle purchase question. They need a different car other than a Ford Taurus because we have too many in our investigations fleet & that is why they got a Volkswagen Passat.

Assistant Superintendent Strayer reported that the jail count is 352. Sheriff Campbell says that they are going to have a Criminal Justice Council to discuss the jail population.
