Department Update Reports

OEM Report: David mentioned that Sean from Pawnee that they are putting into their next budget funds in order to be able to buy new ambulance computers. Pawnee is always on top of everything. During the course of the month, David was over at CWLP last week, they are upgrading around their water plant. One area of great concern is how they are handling the chlorine. CWLP is switching from chlorine in a liquid form to chlorine in a gas form. The safety protocols are really up high on everything that they doing compared to what they use to do in the past. They are going to get the whole Hazmat team there in September for training. Lastly, David mentioned that he's been working with the hospitals in case something was to happen and that they were to have a plan in place. David thinks we are in really good shape in something were to happen in Sangamon County. The hospitals have a plan in place for coordinating a mass casualty that would be closer to the Taylorville and Jacksonville jurisdiction. Coordination would still come from Springfield.

Rescue Squad Report: David reported for Bill that they had air conditioning go out in their training room and the Sheriff's office is going to be using that room for a while coming up so the county electrician is doing that repair for them instead of calling an outside contractor to do the work. Bill is there working with them.

Selection of the next Rescue Squad Chief – David advised the board that Marc Victor has been selected as the next Chief of the Rescue Squad. Marc is a Veteran and has had several deployments to the Middle East; he has a college degree in law enforcement. Marc also is employed at the Sangamon County Dispatch Center and is on third shift. Marc's resume overall just looked fantastic.

SCCDS Report: Director Dodson presented the monthly SCCDS report. Still down 4 dispatchers. 2 of the new hires resigned. Please see attachment. No questions were asked.

Radio Update: Rich advised the board that for a second month in a row there have been no reported hardware issues or complaints. The system has been running good.

New Business: Matt talked briefly about the "I am responding" update. They ran a test on Monday and the test came back fine and as of right now everything seems to be running okay.
