David Mendenhall called the September meeting to order at 12:01 p.m. Member Tony made a motion to approve the August minutes. Member Jeff second. Motion carried. Passed by all.

Visitor Ashley Martin a SCCDS dispatcher was asked to talk about a call she took on midnights at around 4:30 a.m. where a wife called in because her 37 year old husband was unconscious, unresponsive and not breathing on the couch. Ashley instructed the wife to move her husband down on the floor. She then walked her through chest compressions/CPR and kept reassuring her that she was doing good and kept her calm the whole time until the EMT's got there. He was then transported to Memorial. He is alive and doing well. Ashley is being recognized at the County Board meeting next month for her life-saving skills.

Department Update Reports

OEM Report: David mentioned that at the radio meeting in August he presented the projection for the spending plan for this coming current fiscal year and how they are finally in a good position where they can put away some good money. In the four and half years leading up to this they were able to put away 16k. This year OEM got some help from Building and Grounds on a project to repaint the tower and since it is at the County Building, they said they would help with the cost. There should be around 17k to set aside in the coming year. This past month, the week after Labor Day, David mentioned that they had an IEMA conference. With him being the director of the program he has to get at least 48 hours of training in a 2 year span, 24 hours from an IEMA source and 24 hours with an outside source. David plans on having all his hours completed by next May 1. One of the requirements is NIEMS. Lastly, there was also a LEPC meeting and 33 people attended. The Deputy Director from Illinois of Emergency Management came to it. This was their largest meeting yet.

Rescue Squad Report: David advised no big calls since last month. He also mentioned the Chili Super that is October 7th at the Beach House. There will be all you can eat chili and a silent auction.

SCCDS Report: Director Mueller presented the monthly SCCDS report. Still down 5 dispatchers. Please see attachment. No questions were asked.

New Business: Review of the OEM target budget for FY2018. Please see attachment. David had a small budget change for State Reimbursement and changed the 22,000k to 30,000k. David asked the board to approve this change. Member Tony made a motion to approve the change on the 2018 budget. Member Craig second. Motion carried. Passed by all.

Radio Update: Dick advised the board that there have been no reported issued the past month. Dick and Rich met with some people on vehicle repeaters. There was an alarm issue at Shale but has been resolved. Divernon still is having issues with "I am responding" they now are unable to duplicate tickets. Think the problems have to do with internet issues.
