State's Attorney/Probation/District #186: Mike Torchia reported that representatives from the State's Attorney's Office, Probation and Court Services and District #186 met on September 22, 2017 to discuss issues around fights, gangs and the exchange of information.

SIU-SOM/Memorial Behavioral Health Partnership: Mike Torchia reported that the Probation and Court Services Department is continuing to meet with representatives from Southern Illinois University-School of Medicine's (SIU-SOM) and Memorial Behavioral Health to provide more mental health services to both the adult and juvenile criminal justice population. SIU-SOM and Memorial Behavioral Health (MBH) have developed a partnership where SIU-SOM will provide the psychiatric services and MBH will be provide the case management component.

Focused Deterrence Workgroup: John Milhiser gave an update on the Focused Deterrence Workgroup that is being spearheaded by the Springfield Police Department (SPD). The purpose of the project is to
