Administrative Order-Detention Screening Instrument. John Milhiser reported that he has been working with the Judiciary and Court Services to make the temporary override for juveniles, who are arrested for a Class 2 or greater felony to be detained in the Juvenile Detention Center until they go before the Juvenile Judge for further review, permanent. Mr. Milhiser further reported that they also want to include Class 3-Burglary to Motor Vehicle. An Administrative Order was signed by Judge Belz to incorporate these into a new Detention Screening Instrument. Court Services is in the process of modifying the Detention Screening Instrument.

Teen Court-Sierra Senor-Moore reported that she has been doing some research on Teen Courts. Mrs. Senor-Moore passed out an informational sheet, which will be attached to the meeting minutes. The Council indicated that they are interested in pursuing this concept with Springfield School District #186. The next step is for a meeting to occur with representatives from Springfield School District #186.
