7th Judicial Circuit Family Violence Coordinating Council-Mike Torchia reported that Sangamon County will be receiving a \$45,000.00 grant through the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (ICJIA) for SFY 2020. A portion of the grant is being utilized for training. Mike Torchia indicated that if anyone has any training ideas, please let him know.

Juvenile Expungement-There was discussion concerning the new law in regards to the expungement of juvenile records. It was decided that we need to get a meeting together with representatives from Court Services, State's Attorney's Office, Circuit Clerk's Office, the Judiciary and SPD to further discuss this.

Teen Scene-Larry Hemingway Sr. from the Springfield Urban League reported that the Teen Scene that was held on April 5, 2019 was well in attendance. They had approximately 140 students and approximately 18-20 vendors. Larry went on to say that Wal-Mart hired eight teens.

Juvenile Justice Commission-DMC Report. Mike Torchia reported that we have submitted the 2017 juvenile data to the Juvenile Justice Commission. As soon as the Juvenile Justice Commission analyzes the data and sends us the report, we will share the data with the Council.

Teen Court-Crystal Correa reported that she has been in contact with Southeast High School to do a trial in the Fall. Once it is up and going, it may be introduced to Springfield High School. Ms. Senor-Moore indicated that she still needs to have more meetings with Springfield School District #186 administrators. A site visit to North County's Teen Court was conducted. They are looking at referrals for fights and social media threats/issues. They still need to figure out the application process of how someone will be referred or offered Teen Court. The plan is to put together a guide to use as a protocol and outlining types of punishments.
