3. **MINUTES OF MEETING.**

Chairman Brad Mills asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes of the April 18, 2012 Regional Planning Commission meeting. There were none. The minutes were accepted as mailed.

4. **MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE POLICY BOARD.**

There was no meeting of the Executive Policy Board.

5. **REPORT OF OFFICERS.**

Chairman Mills read the following into the record.

"Since the Commission's program year runs from July through June as per our Bylaws, the Commission's June meeting will mark the required Annual Meeting.

Since the terms of officers and members of the Executive Policy Board also run with this period, at the Annual Meeting we will elect officers (a Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary) as well as members of the Executive Policy Board for the next year.

Article 3, Section 2 of our Bylaws calls for the Chairman to name a 3 member committee from the Executive Policy Board to nominate new Commission officers as well as the members of the new Executive Policy Board. As has been past Commission practice, I am naming County Board Chairman Van Meter and Mayor Houston -- or their identified representatives -- to join me on a nominating committee for the purpose of proposing a slate of officers and members of the Executive Policy Board for your consideration.

I would remind the Commission that the Commission's officers must be drawn from the 3 City appointed citizen members and 3 County appointed citizen members, and the Chairmanship must rotate between the City and County members. The Executive Policy Board is made up of the Commission's three officers, the County Board Chair and the Mayor of Springfield, a representative of a special jurisdiction represented on the Commission, and a member-at-large."

There were no other reports from officers.

6. **REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.**

A. **Annual Meeting** – Sims reported that the June Regional Planning Commission will be our annual meeting. Sims encouraged SSCRPC members to attend the meeting as the Annual Report will be presented and election of officers will take place.

B. **Curb Your Car during Bike to Work Week** – Dale Schultz stated that this is the 5<sup>th</sup> annual Curb Your Car event being held from May 14–18, 2012. Residents are encouraged to curb their car and bike, run, walk or take the bus to work. This year's event had 17 sponsors/partners including: Springfield Bicycle Advisory Council, SMTD, St. John's Hospital, Springfield Bicycle Club, and various local bike shops & restaurants. The Team Leader for Sangamon County is Charlie Stratton. Thirty-five people including County Board member, Todd Smith participated in a group ride from Lincoln Park to downtown this morning, Wednesday, May 16. Sims thanked Schultz, the transportation staff and sponsors who coordinated and made this event possible. Sims noted that sponsorship and participation increase every year.

- C. **Project Inventory** – Sims presented a report summarizing the status of the SSCRPC’s current project inventory. (See attached). Projects in the report are those projects aside from general planning for the City of Springfield and Sangamon County. The report includes 53 projects with 28 being still active or in the pipeline.

Sam Cahnman asked about the development of Enos Park Tour Initiative listed in the project inventory. He asked if the tour given to the SDAT team was what was referenced in that project. Sims said no, that the Lincoln Park and Oak Ridge Neighborhood Associations are working with Robert Morris College to digitize tour maps to allow them to be accessed by smart phones, ipads, etc. Sims noted that SSCRPC assistance on the project is completed.

- D. **SDAT Project – Springfield City Center** - Sims noted that the SDAT team thanked the SSCRPC staff for their involvement in the assessment of the Springfield city center. The staff provided info before the team arrived in Springfield as well as provided data and maps as requested when the team was in town.

- E. **Downtown Visitor Pedestrian Survey** - Sims reported that SSCRPC transportation staff will be surveying visitors and residents in downtown Springfield to determine pedestrian movement in the downtown area, where they are coming from and where they are going to.

- F. **Development Activity** - Sims noted that subdivision activity has picked up the past few months.

7. **CORRESPONDENCE.**

There was no correspondence.

8. **PUBLIC HEARING.**

There was no one who wished to address the Commission.

9. **COMMITTEE REPORTS.**

Joe Zeibert presented the following projects to be reviewed by the Planning Commission this month via a power point presentation.

**Schnucks East Subdivision**

**Location & Sketch Map**

**Variance of Sec. 153.157(L) – Restriction of Access**

Description: Pt. SW ¼, Section 36, T16N, R5W

**LSC Action:** Recommend approval of a variance of Sec. 153.157(L) – Restriction of Access and recommend approval of the location & sketch map.

Zeibert stated that this development is located at the southwest corner of Singer Avenue and Dirksen Parkway, north of J.C. Penney, east of the Pepsi plant. A supermarket / retail development is planned for the 11 acre, 2 lot development. Three access points are being requested onto Singer Avenue based on an approved traffic study that will be done with the preliminary plan.

Sims said Schnucks East is a product of joint planning efforts by the SSCRPC, Office of Economic Development and Greater Springfield Chamber of Commerce to encourage commercial redevelopment along the Dirksen Parkway / Cook Street / South Grand corridor.

Cahnman asked if this was the Schnucks planned with an east side location. Sims said yes. Cahnman then asked if the other Schnucks proposed development would require zoning relief. Sims said that proposed development with a west side location would require zoning relief. He noted that it has been reviewed by the Land Subdivision Committee and will come before the Regional Planning Commission once the subject to conditions are met.

**Stone Creek Subdivision**

**Location & Sketch Map**

Description: Pt. SE ¼, SE ¼, Section 2, T15N, R6W

**LSC Action:** Recommend approval of the location & sketch map.

Zeibert stated that this development is located on the east side of Meadowbrook Road, north of Iles Avenue. The development consists of 60 lots on approximately 20 acres. A mixture of residences (single-family, multi-family) is planned on the site.

**Kreston Place**

**Revised Staging Plan**

Description: Pt. E ½, NW ¼, Section 1, T15N, R6W

**LSC Action:** Recommend approval of the revised staging plan.

Zeibert reported that this development is located south of Old Jacksonville Road, west of Koke Mill Road. There are 125 residential lots planned on approximately 74 acres. The revised staging plan was submitted to adjust the phasing of the last preliminary plan.

**Flooring America**

**Site Development Plan**

Description: Pt. NW ¼, Section 19, T15N, R5W

**LSC Action:** Recommend approval of the site development plan.

Zeibert stated that the proposed 1 lot development is located in Prairie Crossing in front of Meijers on 1.80 acres. It will have a shared access easement off of Chuckwagon Drive.

**South Fifth Street Partnership**

**Site Development Plan**

Description: Pt. SW ¼, Section 34, T16N, R5W

**LSC Action:** Recommend approval of the site development plan.

Zeibert said the proposed development is located at 1240 South 6<sup>th</sup> Street. There is a building at Vine & 6<sup>th</sup> and the owners want to construct a new building. The site plan process was required since the building to the north is served by a private access drive through the existing lot.

*Kenneth Springs moved concur with the action of the Land Subdivision Committee on the above listed subdivisions. Mike Farmer seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.*

**10. UNFINISHED BUSINESS.**

There was no unfinished business.

11. NEW BUSINESS.

Mike Farmer said it was a pleasure to work with various agencies on the East Side Community Redevelopment Plan.

Farmer encouraged Commission members to attend the unveiling of the Lincoln Penny bike rack downtown at Café Moxo. He noted that the bike racks were paid for by Central Area TIF in an effort to make Springfield more bicycle / pedestrian friendly.
