# Introduction

This report lists all Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Authority (FTA) surface transportation projects in Sangamon County receiving Federal funds during the 2017 fiscal year (July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017). Projects which have been listed in the Springfield Area Transportation Study (SATS) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) include a TIP project number.

All references to project descriptions, bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, and project phases of work were obtained from SATS TIP documents and from the 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan if the project appeared in those documents. Federal highway funding obligation data for FY 2017 and federal funding sources were obtained from the Federal Highway Administration FMIS report for Sangamon County. Federal transit funding obligation data was provided by the Springfield Mass Transit District.

For some projects, the federal funding obligation listed in the FMIS report was different than the amount of federal funds reported in the SATS TIP. For these cases, a column was included in the Project Listings table to show the difference between the two totals if the obligated amount was less than the TIP amount.

Most projects in the Project Listings have been assigned a map number and have been included in a map at the end of this document. Projects in the table that were not assigned map numbers involve multiple project locations that were hard to illustrate or were located outside of the Metropolitan Planning Area and thus were not mapped.
