



RESOLUTION TO ENDORSE
AMENDMENT THIRTY SECOND TO THE
2040 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Springfield Area Transportation Study (SATS), in cooperation with the Illinois Department of Transportation, has a comprehensive, cooperative, and continuing (3C) planning process for transportation planning in compliance with Federal regulations for the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the SATS Long Range Transportation Plan takes a long-term (25-year) look at transportation needs in the Springfield Metropolitan Planning Area; envisions an efficient, interconnected, multi-modal travel network; and identifies projects to make this vision a reality; and

WHEREAS, the Long Range Transportation Plan is updated every five years and was most recently updated on March 12, 2015 as the SATS 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, all projects with identified funding sources and anticipated to be completed during the period 2015 – 2019 are listed as Committed Projects in the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Transportation, Region 4 District 6 is undertaking a Statewide Pavement Preservation program. The longitudinal joints, at the location described below, are beginning to open and secondary cracks away from the joints are developing. A Microsurfacing Joint Repair will fill minor surface irregularities and seal the pavement surface in these longitudinal joint areas and help to preserve the surface life of this pavement.; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Transportation, Region 4 District 6 requests that the following project be added to the "Committed Projects" list in the SATS 2040 LRTP; and
