I. CALL TO ORDER

III. 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)

Shannan Karrick told the Committee that SSCRPC was preparing the 3.5 Year Progress Report to the 2040 LRTP.

IV. 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program

A. ST-U Projects Update

TJ Heavisides announced the following:

i. Archer Elevator Road: Wabash Avenue to Greenbriar Drive

The project was anticipated to have a January, 2019 letting. Project design was in the process of being completed and approved.

ii. East Walnut Street: Park Avenue to Meadow View Lane (Chatham)

No update was given.

Brian Davis announced the following:

iii. Iron Bridge Road and Woodside Road underpasses

Iron Bridge Road land acquisition was complete. Woodside Road land acquisition was proceeding, and a meeting with the land acquisition consultant was scheduled. A petition for project funding was in progress and the Illinois Commerce Commission was notified of the County's intention to proceed with the project.

iv. Woodside Road: IL-4 to Chatham Road

The project was underway. Some utility relocations were still in progress and a fall, 2018 completion date was anticipated.

B. Annual Listing of Federally Obligated Projects FY2018

Neha Soni told the Committee that the Annual Listing of Federally Obligated Projects for FY2018 was complete and available for Committee and public review.

A. Illinois Dept. of Transportation (IDOT): Central Bureau of Urban Program Planning

D. Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC)

E. Springfield Airport Authority

Mr. Blickensderfer told the Committee that the Airport had two projects working at the time of the meeting. The first project rebuilt the fixed-base operator hanger. The second project was to upgrade the perimeter road around the Airport.

Mr. Blickensderfer told the Committee that work was scheduled to begin the next week to replace the parking lot and circulation roads within the airport. The project would consolidate the parking lots and create a true circulation road within the Airport.

Mr. Blickensderfer announced that the Airport had received Federal grants to begin two projects in the main airport terminal. The first project to renovate the west side of the terminal was scheduled to last approximately three more months. The second grant was for a project to renovate the front of the main terminal, particularly the ticket counter area and baggage claim. The \$7.4 million project was let and awarded to R.D. Lawrence. The project was anticipated to start in early 2019.
